RESOLUTION NO. 2021-004

IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY-RELATED REAL AND PERSONAL  
PROPERTY TAX LEVIES FOR COLLECTION IN 2022

**WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to express the county-related tax levy needs and intentions for collection in 2022 based on the certified values provided by the County Assessor; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board, as the legislative authority for Pacific County, is responsible for determining and fixing the tax levies intended to be used for county general purposes and county road purposes; now, therefore

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Pacific County Commissioners that the County Assessor and County Treasurer are authorized and directed to include county-related tax levies within the tax rolls for collection in 2022 as follows:

- County General Purposes – \$4,259,969 or the maximum available within the \$1.80 statutory levy and 101% limitations.
- County Road Purposes - \$3,479,977 or the maximum available within the \$2.25 statutory levy and 101% limitations.

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED** that the general purposes regular property tax levy proceeds shall be distributed as follows: a) \$92,000 to the Public Health and Human Services Fund No. 118 for support of certain qualified human service activities not to exceed a rate of \$0.025/\$1,000 Assessed Value, and b) the remaining \$4,167,969 to the General (Current Expense) Fund No. 001.

**PASSED** by the following vote this 6<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2021 by the Board of Pacific County Commissioners meeting in continued session at South Bend, Washington, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage:
