Pacific County Department of Public Works solicited bids for:

31.52 miles	Skip Center Stripe
4.33 miles	Skip Center Stripe with No Pass Stripe
34.21 miles	Double Yellow No Pass Center Stripe
141.82 miles	Fog Edge Stripe

One (1) bids were received from the solicitation.

This office recommends the purchase of a reduced quantity of 19.54 miles of Skip Center Stripe, 3.30 miles of Skip Center Stripe with No Pass Stripe, 32.06 miles of Double Yellow No Pass Center Stripe, and 99.18 miles of Fog Edge Stripe, based on the significant cost overrun over the estimate, from Specialized Pavement Markings, LLC in the amount of \$214,891.75, per the attached revised Tally. Bids include sales tax and installation.

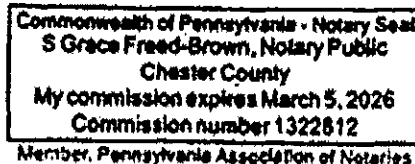



APPENDIX 2: CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this. _____ of _____ 2023, between the Board of County Commissioners of Pacific County, State of Washington, hereinafter called the County and _____, hereinafter called the Contractor.

WITNESSETH

That in consideration of the terms and conditions herein and attached and made a part of this agreement, the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

1. **2023 Pacific County Pavement Striping Services**, in accordance with and as described in the Project Bidding Documents attendant to the Call for Bids for said project including all attachments thereto, and in accordance with the attached plans and specifications, and the *Standard Specifications of the Washington State Department of Transportation*, all of which are, by this reference, incorporated herein and made a part hereof in toto, and Contractor shall perform any changes in the work in accordance with the Contract Documents. The Contractor shall provide and bear the expense of all equipment work, and labor of any sort whatsoever that may be required for the transfer of materials and for constructing and completing the work provided for in these Contract Documents except those items mentioned therein to be furnished by the County.
2. The County hereby promises and agrees with the Contractor to contract with, and does contract with the Contractor to provide the materials and to do and cause to be done the above described work and to complete and finish the same in accord with the attached plans and specifications and the schedule of unit or itemized prices at the time and in the manner and upon the condition provided for in this contract.
3. The Contractor for his/her self, and for their heirs, executors, administrator, successors, and assigns, does hereby agree to the full performance of all the covenants herein contained upon the part of the Contractor.
4. It is further provided that no liability shall attach to the County by reasons of entering into this contract, except as expressly provided herein.
5. **Public Records Act.** This Agreement and all public records associated with this Agreement shall be available from the County for inspection and copying by the public where required by the Public Records Act, Chapter 42.56 RCW (the "Act"). To the extent that public records then in the custody of the Contractor are needed for the County to respond to a request under the Act, as determined by the County, the Contractor agrees to make them promptly available to the County. If the Contractor considers any portion of any record provided to the County under this Agreement, whether in electronic or hard copy form, to be protected from disclosure under law, the Contractor shall clearly identify any specific information that it claims to be confidential or proprietary. If the County receives a request under the Act to inspect or copy the information so identified by the Contractor and the County determines that release of the information is required by the Act or otherwise appropriate, the County's sole obligations shall be to notify the Contractor (a) of the request and (b) of the date that such information will be released to the requester unless the Contractor obtains a court order to enjoin that disclosure pursuant to RCW 42.56.540. If the Contractor fails to timely obtain a court order enjoining disclosure, the County will release the requested information on the date specified.

The County has, and by this section assumes, no obligation on behalf of the Contractor to claim any exemption from disclosure under the Act. The County shall not be liable to the Contractor for releasing records not clearly identified by the Contractor as confidential or proprietary. The County shall not be liable to the Contractor for any records that the County releases in compliance with this section or in compliance with an order of a court of competent jurisdiction.

Contractor agrees to indemnify and, to the greatest extent legally possible, to hold harmless the County in any action by a third party due to the negligence, recklessness or intentional actions by the Contractor relating to its performance of this contract. This includes any lawsuit filed by a third party for the County's allegedly improper release of confidential or proprietary information pursuant to a public records request.

6. **Ownership.** Any and all data, reports, analyses, documents, photographs, pamphlets, plans, specifications, surveys, films or any other materials created, prepared, produced, constructed, assembled, made, performed or otherwise produced by the Contractor or the Contractor's subcontractors or consultants for delivery to the County under this Agreement shall be the sole and absolute property of the County. Such property shall constitute "work made for hire" as defined by the U.S. Copyright Act of 1976, 17 U.S.C. § 101, and the ownership of the copyright and any other intellectual property rights in such property shall vest in the County at the time of its creation. Ownership of the intellectual property includes the right to copyright, patent, and register, and the ability to transfer these rights. Material which the Contractor uses to perform this Agreement but is not created, prepared, constructed, assembled, made, performed or otherwise produced for or paid for by the County is owned by the Contractor and is not "work made for hire" within the terms of this Agreement.

Any and all data, reports, analyses, documents, photographs, pamphlets, plans, specifications, surveys, films or any other materials created, prepared, produced, constructed, assembled, made, performed or otherwise produced by the Contractor or the Contractor's subcontractors or consultants for delivery to the County under this Agreement shall be the sole and absolute property of the County. Such property shall constitute "work made for hire" as defined by the U.S. Copyright Act of 1976, 17 U.S.C. § 101, and the ownership of the copyright and any other intellectual property rights in such property shall vest in the County at the time of its creation. Ownership of the intellectual property includes the right to copyright, patent, and register, and the ability to transfer these rights. Material which the Contractor uses to perform this Agreement but is not created, prepared, constructed, assembled, made, performed or otherwise produced for or paid for by the County is owned by the Contractor and is not "work made for hire" within the terms of this Agreement.

7. **Indemnification by Contractor.** To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend and hold the County and its departments, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and volunteers, harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including but not limited to court costs, attorney's fees and alternative dispute resolution costs, for any personal injury, for any bodily injury, sickness, disease or death and for any damage to or destruction of any property, including the loss of use resulting therefrom. The indemnity includes but is not limited to: 1) liability arising in whole or in part by any action or omission, negligent or otherwise, of the Contractor, its employees, agents or volunteers or Contractor's subcontractors and their employees, agents or volunteers; or 2) liability directly or indirectly arising out of, resulting from, or in connection with performance of this Contract; or 3) liability based upon the Contractor's or its subcontractors' use of, presence upon or proximity to the property of the County. This indemnification obligation of the Contractor shall not apply in the limited circumstance where the claim, damage, loss or expense is caused by the sole negligence of the County. This indemnification obligation of the Contractor shall not be limited in any way by the Washington State Industrial Insurance Action RCW Title 51, or by application of any other workmen's compensation act, disability benefit act or other employee benefit act, and the Contractor hereby expressly waives any immunity afforded by such acts. The foregoing indemnification obligations of the Contractor are a material inducement to County to enter into the Contract, are reflected in the Contractor's compensation, and have been mutually negotiated by the parties.
8. **Participation County – No Waiver.** The County reserves the right, but not the obligation, to participate in the defense of any claim, damages, losses or expenses and such participation shall not constitute a waiver of Contractor's indemnity obligations under the Contract.

9. **Survival of Contractor's Indemnity Obligations.** The Contractor agrees all Contractors' indemnity obligations shall survive the completion, expiration or termination of this Contract.
10. **Insurance.** Without limiting the Contractor's indemnification of County, and prior to commencement of this Contract, Contractor shall obtain, provide and maintain during the term of this Contract, policies or insurance of the type and amounts described below and in a form satisfactory to the County.
- a. **General Liability Insurance.** Contractor shall maintain commercial general liability insurance with coverage at least as broad as Insurance Services Office form CG 00 01, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 general aggregate, for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage, including without limitation, blanket contractual liability.
 - b. **Professional Liability (Errors & Omissions) Insurance.** Contractor shall maintain professional liability insurance that covers the services to be performed in connection with this Contract, in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 per claim and in the aggregate. Any policy inception date, continuity date, or retroactive date must be before the effective date of this Contract and Contractor agrees to maintain continuous coverage through a period no less than three years after completion of the services required by this Contract.
 - c. **Workers' Compensation Insurance.** Contractor shall, at its own expense, maintain Workers' Compensation Insurance (Statutory Limits) and Employer's Liability Insurance (with limits of at least \$1,000,000).
- Contractor shall submit to County, along with the certificate of insurance, a Waiver of Subrogation endorsement in favor of County, its officers, agents, employees and volunteers.
- d. **Waiver of Subrogation.** All insurance coverage maintained or procured pursuant to this Contract shall be endorsed to waive subrogation against County, its elected or appointed officers, agents, officials, employees and volunteers or shall specifically allow Contractor or others providing insurance evidence in compliance with these specifications to waive their right of recovery prior to a loss. Contractor hereby waives its own right of recovery against County, and shall require similar written express waivers and insurance clauses from each of its subcontractors.
 - e. **Automobile Liability Insurance.** Consultant shall maintain automobile insurance at least as broad as Insurance Services Office form CA 00 01 covering bodily injury and property damage for all activities of the Consultant arising out of or in connection with Work to be performed under this Agreement, including coverage for any owned, hired, non-owned or rented vehicles, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit for each accident.

The Contractor shall provide the County with properly executed certificate of insurance and provide a policy endorsement naming the County as an additional insured. Contractor agrees that its liability insurance shall be primary and non-contributory to the County's and that Contractor's liability insurance policy shall so state.

11. **Attorney's Fees/Cost of Suit and Venue.** If either party files suit to enforce this Contract, parties agree that the prevailing party in any such action shall be entitled to collection costs, reasonable attorney's fees, and costs of suit.
12. **Disputes.** Differences between the Contractor and the County, arising under and by virtue of this Contract, shall be brought to the attention of the County at the earliest possible time in order that such matters may be settled or other appropriate action promptly taken. Any dispute relating to the quality or acceptability of

performance and/or compensation due Contractor shall be decided by the County's Contract representative or designee. All rulings, orders, instructions and decisions of the County's contract representative shall be final and conclusive, subject to their right to seek judicial relief pursuant to **Choice of Law, Jurisdiction and Venue**.

13. **Choice of Law, Jurisdiction and Venue.** This Contract has been and shall be construed as having been made and delivered within the State of Washington and it is agreed by each party hereto that this Contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Washington, both as to its interpretation and performance.

Any action at law, suit in equity, or judicial proceeding arising out of this Contract shall be instituted and maintained only in any of the courts of competent jurisdiction in Pacific County, Washington.

14. **Severability.** If a court of competent jurisdiction holds any part, term or provision of this Contract to be illegal, or invalid in whole or in part, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected, and the parties' rights and obligations shall be construed and enforced as if the Contract did not contain the particular provision held to be invalid.

If any provision of this Contract is in direct conflict with any statutory provision of the State of Washington, that provision which may conflict shall be deemed inoperative and null and void insofar as it may conflict, and shall be deemed modified to conform to such statutory provision.

Should the County determine that the severed portions substantially alter this Contract so that the original intent and purpose of the Contract no longer exists, the County may, in its sole discretion, terminate this Contract.

15. **Contract Provisions.** Payments due to the Contractor under this Agreement are expressly conditioned upon the Contractor's strict compliance with all insurance requirements under this Agreement. Payment to the Contractor shall be suspended in the event of non-compliance. Upon receipt of evidence of full compliance, payments not otherwise subject to withholding or set-off will be released to the Contractor.
