

RAINBOW VALLEY LANDFILL – POST CLOSURE FUNDING AGREEMENT

Amendment No. 6

This amendment is made as of the _____ day of _____, 202__, among Larry Bale, individually, Rainbow Valley Landfill, Inc., its shareholders and officers, hereinafter called “RVL”, and Pacific County, a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Washington, by and through the Board of Pacific County Commissioners, constituting the Pacific County Board of Health, hereinafter called “BOH” and together called the “Parties”.

The amendment should become effective on the 1st day of January, 2023, and contain the following amendments.

- I. Section B shall read as follows:
 - a. The term of this Agreement shall be deemed to be effective as of April 1, 1997, and shall terminate December 31, 2027, or at termination of post closure status, whichever occurs sooner.
- II. Section I shall read as follows:
 - a. Upon giving no less than thirty-days advance written notice to the Parties, Northern Pacific Council of Governments, Peninsula Sanitation, Inc., and Pacific Solid Waste Disposal, Inc., this Agreement may be modified by mutual agreement among the Parties at any time prior to its expiration date of December 31, 2027.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this amendment to the RAINBOW VALLEY LANDFILL – POST CLOSURE FUNDING AGREEMENT to be executed by their duly authorized officers or representatives and which is effective as of January 1st, 2023.
