PURPOSE OF THE CHANGE: To amend the contract between Know and Grow and Pacific County.

1. Pacific County is electing to amend KNOW AND GROW's contract for Behavioral Health to include \$5,000 of additional funds from Milage funds to cover Coalition Coordinator Costs.
2. A new budget and statement of work, labeled as Behavioral Health Contract K&G - Amendment #1, provides the budget for the additional funding.

Contract #: 2022-2023 Behavioral Health K&G**Summary statement of work**

Like many rural communities, our area is economically depressed. Pacific County residents experience social problems such as mental illness and substance abuse at higher rates than average, which increases the number of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) experienced by our community's youth. This coupled with our geographic distance from services are cause for concern. Behavioral health resources for children in particular can be difficult to access. Our childcares and early learning programs are often understaffed and overburdened, and it can be difficult to fit professional development in.

This project is centered on reducing prevalence of ACEs among Pacific County youth by providing training on trauma informed care to early learning providers in our community. Training coupled with resources will improve the quality of care available to young children in our community, resulting in more resilient youth and reduction of future mental health issues, incarceration, and substance use rates, and increase of academic and economic outcomes.

Community mental health support is a large part of the early learning coalition's mission, and Rhonda's job is to coordinate and oversee our efforts. Currently Rhonda is in process of linking up to 150 early learning providers, community partners, parents and caregivers of youth age birth through age 8 with licenses to Conscious Discipline. This will allow individuals to complete ten self-paced modules for over 20 hours of individualized training.
