Amendment #1- CIHS Jail Behavioral Health

PURPOSE OF THE CHANGE: To amend the contract between CIHS and Pacific County.

IT IS MUTUTALLY AGREED AND THEREFORE THE CONTRACT IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pacific County is electing to amend CIHS's contract to extend the duration of the contract to December 31, 2023.
2. Pacific County is electing to amend CIHS's original budget to add \$30,000 of CJTA funds and \$24,000 of BJAA 2nd Chance Reentry funds to the original contract amount.
3. Replaces exhibit A statement of work with exhibit A statement of work amendment #1
4. Replaces exhibit B budget with exhibit B budget amendment #1.
5. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS of the original contract and Amendments shall remain in full force and effect.
6. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties hereto on separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original but such counterparts together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

2021-2022

Overview of Behavioral Health Services to be provided

- 1) Community Integrated Health Services (CIHS) will implement conduct Mental Health, Co-occurring and Substance Use Disorder assessments and appropriate MH/SUD/COD treatment with criminal justice involved individuals who are involved in the Pacific County criminal justice system and/or in the Pacific County jail.
- 2) CIHS will identify and assign a Mental Health Professional and a Substance Use Disorder Professional or a Co-occurring Disorder Professional for up to a total of a .5fte for this project.
- 3) Services can be provided in person inside the jail or through telehealth as the Pandemic and appropriate/safe staffing allow.
- 4) CIHS will provide services around the jail schedule working with the jail liaison to identify available times to conduct assessments and provide treatment to inmates.

Behavioral Health Assessments	Pacific County recognizes that Behavioral Health Professionals have the ability to diagnose a Substance Use Disorder. Should an inmate also need an ASAM level of care established, CIHS will work with the jail liaison to schedule the additional assessment with a Substance Use Disorder Professional.	CJTA
	CIHS will provide appropriate treatment for the jail setting with the appropriate Behavioral Health Professional (ie. MH, SUD or COD)	CJTA for SUD, 2nd Chance Reentry for MH and COD
Parameters for Assessments and Treatment	1) Assessments will be arranged by county staff based on the referral process used by Pacific County Health and Human Services and Pacific County Jail. 2) Assessment and treatment dates and times will be coordinated between the county and CIHS 3) Due to jail movements and office space availability, no office space will be provided. Assessments and treatment will be held in the "Client/Attorney" room, via telehealth, or in other areas deemed appropriate by the jail. Post assessment paperwork and follow up communications will be completed offsite.	
Supervision and Communication	Assigned employees will abide by all Pacific County Jail rules and protocols. This is to maintain the safety of staff, corrections officers and inmates. Should problems arise within the jail, communications will follow Pacific County Jail's chain of command and be reported back to identified supervisor(s) at CIHS for discussion and resolution. Issues with process or Health Department staff would be reported to Health Department management. Conversely, if CIHS assigned staff have concerns, county supervisors should be made aware by a member of CIHS staff/supervisory team. and must be able to successfully pass a Pacific County Sheriff's office background check	
Training and Licensures	CIHS will assure that all assigned employees are up to date on their state licenses and provide license numbers to contractor upon request. Assigned staff members will attend trainings identified by the contractor as beneficial or necessary for work with this population.	CJTA for SUD, 2nd Chance Reentry for MH and COD
Reporting	CIHS will submit to Pacific County a monthly report by the 5th of the month after services are provided using a template provided by the county. Back up documentation for all expenses and services shall be kept by CIHS and provided to the county upon request. This may include but is not limited to: Number of clients served (how many individuals requested services, how many assessments/treatment sessions of which type were completed), Demographic information, whether the individual is experiencing mental health issues, substance use disorder, or has a co-occurring disorder, whether the individual is a participant/referred to drug court or other therapeutic court, invoices, timecards, receipts and other documentation to support expenditures under this contract. CIHS will track and submit data to support CJTA, 2nd Chance Reentry reporting as requested by the county.	CJTA for SUD, 2nd Chance Reentry for MH and COD
