

AMENDMENT TO SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Amendment"), dated May 1, 2020, is made and entered by and between Molina Healthcare of Washington, Inc. ("Health Plan") and PACIFIC COUNTY HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPT ("Provider").


Whereas, Health Plan and Provider entered into a Services Agreement ("Agreement"), as amended.

Per direction of the Washington State Office of the Insurance Commissioner, and in accordance with Section 2.9, Compliance with Applicable Law, and Section 5.6, Amendment, the Agreement is hereby amended to incorporate the requirements applicable to health carriers and health care providers and facilities set forth in the Washington State Emergency Orders and Governor's Proclamation identified below. This Amendment is solely for the purpose to implement the requirements of the below-referenced emergency orders and proclamation for the time period set forth therein, and as may subsequently be modified by the State of Washington.

1. Emergency Order #20-01 ordering covered COVID-19 testing, one-time refills of covered prescriptions prior to the expiration of the waiting period between refills, suspension of any prior authorization requirements that apply to covered diagnostic testing and treatment of COVID-19 and ensuring access to COVID-19 testing during the period of March 5, 2020 through May 4, 2020.
