

AMENDMENT #2

PURPOSE OF THE CHANGE: To amend the contract between **Coastal Community Action Program** and **Pacific County**.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THEREFORE: That the contract is hereby updated as follows:

1. Section VII: Criminal Background Check – No staff shall have unsupervised access to any clients prior to the completion of the background check.
2. All references to DDD have been replaced with DDA.
3. Remove references of Person to Person as outlined in Section iii within Exhibit A – Statement of Work.
4. Section i within Exhibit A – Statement of Work: Clients in an employment programs will be supported to work towards a living wage. A living wage is the amount needed to enable an individual to meet or exceed his or her living expenses. Clients should average twenty (20) hours work per week or eight six (86) hours per month. The amount of service a client receives should be based on his/her demonstrated need, desire, and acuity level.

Has been replaced with:

Clients in an employment programs will be supported to work towards a living wage. A living wage is the amount needed to enable an individual to meet or exceed his or her living expenses. Clients will work preferred hours. The amount of service a client receives should be based on his/her demonstrated need, desire, and acuity level. Employer will comply with the County Program Agreement between DDA and Pacific County will provide DDA evidence upon request.

5. Updates policy reference to mandatory reporter from 5.13 to 6.08 per DDA policy updates.

ALL OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS of the original contract shall remain in full force and effect.
