



PACIFIC COUNTY COURTHOUSE AND OFFICES TO RE-OPEN

Pacific County, as an essential business, will be re-opening our buildings to the public soon! But before we do, we are making changes to ensure the health and safety of our residents, visitors, and employees. The dates for re-opening are Tuesday, June 2nd for north county facilities, and Monday, June 15th for our south county facilities.

Here are some of the changes you will see:

- 1) You will be required to wear a mask while visiting county offices.
- 2) You will be required to follow social distancing guidelines. As such, we will limit the number of people allowed in the county facilities at any one time. But rest assured, we will do our best to move everyone in and out as quickly as possible.
- 3) You will only be able to enter the Courthouse through the rear door.
