The on-site septic system (OSS) for this parcel was issued as a "non-conforming" repair (as allowed in Pacific County Board of Health (BOH) Ordinance 3E Section 26 Table VI (or any amendment thereto)). A Table VI repair is a pre-approved waiver for a system to be installed to serve an existing residence when current regulations cannot be met. If the Table VI repair process did not exist, an OSS repair permit could not be issued and the property owner would be required to abandon their residence. Because a system that cannot meet current regulations has a higher potential to cause a public health hazard, a condition of the approval is that the OSS must have increased monitoring and maintenance requirements. To meet the conditions of the OSS permit, the current property owner is required to maintain an annual Operational Permit and have the OSS system inspected by a County licensed Operational & Maintenance Inspector on a yearly basis as per BOH Ordinance No. 3E Section 23.2 (or any amendment thereto). This will ensure that any future problems with the OSS system are discovered and corrected to prevent any potential hazards to public health.

The Operational Permit and inspection requirement were conditions of approval for this OSS permit. Failure to meet the terms of the OSS repair permit and Operational Permit will cause the OSS repair permit to be voided as per BOH Ordinance No. 3E Section 9.10 (or any amendment thereto), which will result in further action against the current property owner. This action may include a civil infraction as allowed in Board of Health Ordinance No. 1 (or any amendment thereto).
